Notations

- An antique is recognized as an item which is at least 50 years old.
- Historical interest and approximate age of entry would be appreciated but not necessary for a prize.
- Small cracks / flaws will not disqualify items.
- Items must be small enough to be hand held.
- Only amateurs may enter; no collectors.
- Items will be displayed in a fenced area.

Prizes

3. Early piece of glassware. (e.g. goblet, cake plate, etc.)
4. Coin, token or paper money.
5. Christmas ornament or decoration.
6. Cookbook.
7. Magazine.
8. Hand tool, no larger than 18".
9. Postcard.
10. Calendar.
11. Handkerchief.
12. Woman's gloves.
13. Advertisement / shop sign.
14. Any item of Canadiana.
