

## Class U1: Junior Exhibition

Exhibits are to be displayed in the Main Exhibition Hall.

### Prizes

1<sup>st</sup> - \$4, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$3, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$2



### Section: Ages 6 Years and Under

1. A collection of any six items in a six-section egg carton.
2. Make vehicle out of dried pasta, display on a paper plate.
3. Decorate three Easter eggs, display on a paper plate or some other way to keep them together.
4. Use a wooden clothespin to make a bird.
5. Use buttons to create a picture of a flower on paper or Bristol board, no larger than 8.5" x 11".
6. Use a sponge or potato print to create a painting of a barn, no larger than 12" x 18".

### Section: Ages 7 to 11 years

7. Create a lantern from a clean tin can, candle not required to be included.
8. Make a Christmas angel using dried pasta, may be mounted on Bristol board.
9. Create any item using a pinecone (s).
10. Make a bird feeder using any material no larger than 12" x 12".
11. Any scene, painted in acrylic, oil or water-based paints, on a canvas, no larger than 12" x 18".
12. Make a necklace using any materials.



### Section: Ages 12 to 16 years

13. Create a log cabin and scene using any material, mounted on a paper plate or cardboard no larger than 12" x 12".
14. Make a Christmas tree decoration (1), must be ready to hang or hanging and mounted.
15. Create a split picture by cutting any photograph in half and recreating the missing half.
16. Create any item using origami.

17. Create a person out of nuts, bolts, screws, etc., no larger than 8".

18. Melt crayons to create an artistic design.

## Class U2: Junior Vegetables / Flowers

Exhibits are to be displayed in the Ag Produce Building.

### Prizes

1<sup>st</sup> - \$4, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$3, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$2

### Section: Ages 6 Years and Under

1. Vegetable animal, combination of whole or carved vegetables, no larger than 18" x 18" x 18".
2. "Mellow Yellow": use a 500-mL milk container to display fresh yellow flowers.
3. My Favorite Flower: 3 fresh stems or blooms.



### Section: Ages 7 to 11 years

4. Any plant started from seed displayed in a suitable container.
5. Tea for Two: fresh flower arrangement in a teapot.
6. "Floral arrangement for Mom" in a mug; artificial flowers are not permitted.



## Class U3: Junior Baking

Exhibits are to be displayed in the Main Exhibit Hall.

### Prizes

1<sup>st</sup> - \$4, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$3, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$2

### Section: Ages 6 and under

1. Three decorated cupcakes to be judged on appearance only.
2. One large cookie no bigger than 6" diameter, decorated, to be judged on appearance only.

### Section: Ages 7 to 11 years

3. No bake cookies or squares (3), named.
4. Party mix (sometimes called nuts and bolts), in a jar.

### Section: Ages 12 to 16 years

5. Strawberry freezer jam, 250 mL or 500 mL jar.
6. Muffins of any kind, 3, on a plate and in a bag per Class M requirements, named.

### Section: OAAS Chocolate Chip Cookie, open to all children up to age 15 years of age as of December 31<sup>st</sup> of the current year.

7. Three plain chocolate chip cookies, without nuts, no larger than 3" diameter each and no larger than 2" diameter.



## Class U4: Junior Posters

Exhibits are to be displayed in the Main Exhibit Hall.

### Prizes

1<sup>st</sup> - \$10, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$8, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$5

### Section: OAAS Poster Competition

1. Open to youth enrolled up to Grade 4.
2. Open to youth enrolled in Grades 5 to 8.
3. Open to youth enrolled in Grades 9 to 12.

### Notations

- Hand drawn poster to promote the Fair.
- Name and 2019 dates must be included.
- Minimum size of 22 cm X 28 cm.
- Maximum size of 28 cm X 44 cm.
- Entry must be centered on a cardstock or Bristol board exposing a 5.5 cm border.
- 1<sup>st</sup> prize winning posters will be retained for competition at the District Fair meeting.

## Class U5: Junior Maple Produce

Exhibits are to be displayed in the Ag Produce Building.

### Notations

- Exhibitor provides all label-free containers.
- Syrup must have been manufactured by the Exhibitor during the 2019 season.
- The Exhibitor's name must NOT appear on the exhibits until after the judging.

### Section: Ages 13 Years and Under

1. Maple syrup, any grade, one bottle.
2. Maple Sugar, ¼ lb. hard cake in transparent wrap.
3. Maple Sugar, soft creamed, ¼ lb. freezer bag of small pieces.
4. Maple butter, one jar.
5. 8 ½ "x 11" pencil crayon poster of a sugar bush.
