Prizes

1st - \$4, 2nd - \$3, 3rd - \$2

Section: Ages 6 Years and Under

Notation

- The first three items in this section are to be displayed and judged in the Agricultural Produce Building.

- Vegetable animal, combination of whole or carved vegetables, no larger than 18" x 18" x 18".
- "Mellow Yellow": use a 500-mL milk container to display fresh yellow flowers.
- My Favorite Flower: 3 fresh stems or blooms.
- Decorated paper plate mask.
- Make and decorated a crown.
- Homemade mail box; decorate a Kleenex box.
- Trace your hand and decorate.
- Popsicle stick creation, any subject.
- Animal(s) photo, 4" x 6", in decorated frame.
- Finger painting of a tractor, 11" x 17".

Section: Ages 7 to 11 years

Notation

- The first three items in this section are to be displayed and judged in the Agricultural Produce Building.

- Any plant started from seed displayed in a suitable container.
- Tea for Two: fresh flower arrangement in a teapot.
- "Floral arrangement for Mom" in a mug; artificial flowers are not permitted.
- Chocolate chip cookies, no nuts (3).

Notation

- This section can be cross entered into OAAS Section 4.
- Cupcakes, iced, (3), fair theme, judged on Appearance only.
 - Christmas tree ornament.
 - Mini-hockey stick; decorated.

- Vehicle made with Lego, Kinex or Magnetix, no kits.
- Computer generated poster advertising the 188th Delta Fair.
- Jewellery, 1 item, any media, no kit.
- Fair scene using markers.
- Collage of Animals, 11" x 17".
- Duct tape creature, no larger than 18" x 18" x 18".
- Summer vacation photo, 4" x 6", in decorated frame.
- Card, birthday message, any media.
- Sock puppet.

Section: Ages 12 to 16 years

- Banana muffins (3).
- Fudge, any kind, named (3).
- Chocolate chip cookies (3).



Notation

- Entry can be cross entered into OAAS Section 4 provided the Exhibitor is no more than 15 yrs old as of December 31st.
- Jewelry, 1 item, any media, no kits.
 - Wind chime made from kitchen and/or household items.

Section 4: OAAS Poster Competition

Prizes

1st - \$10, 2nd - \$8, 3rd - \$5

- Open to youth enrolled up to / in Grade 4.
- Open to youth enrolled in Grades 5 to 8.
- Open to youth enrolled in Grades 9 to 12.

Notations

- Poster is to promote the Delta Fair.
- Name and 2018 dates must be included.
- Minimum size of 22 cm X 28 cm.
- Maximum size of 28 cm X 44 cm.
- Each entry must be centered on a cardstock or bristol board exposing a 5.5 cm border on all sides.
- 1st prize winning posters will be retained for competition at the District Fair level in October.
