Participant Eligibility

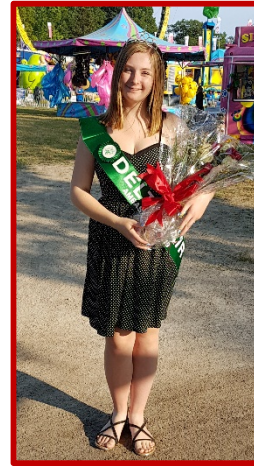
- Must reside within Leeds County.

- Must be present at the fair to participate in the Opening Ceremonies, to present rosettes / awards at various events, to participate in media events, and to greet patrons.
- May be required to present awards at community events, attend OAAS functions and volunteer at Society Festivals.

Criteria

- Participants will be judged on personality, charm, appearance, deportment, community knowledge and involvement.
- Participants will be required to deliver a 3-5-minute speech on any topic pertaining to rural living or the Delta Fair.
- Participants will participate in a 10-minute pre-pageant interview.
