Notations

- An antique is recognized as an item which is at least 50 years old.
- Historical interest and approximate age of entry would be appreciated but not necessary for a prize.
- Small cracks / flaws will not disqualify items.
- Items must be small enough to be handheld.
- Only amateurs may enter, no collectors.
- Items will be displayed in a fenced area.

Prizes

1st - \$6, 2nd - \$5, 3rd - \$4

Sections

1. Teacup and saucer.
2. Early kitchen utensil. (e.g., washboard, rolling pin, mixing bowl, butter print, etc.)
3. Early piece of glassware. (e.g., goblet, cake plate, etc.)
4. Church plate – commemorative or souvenir.
5. Coin, token, or paper money.
6. Christmas ornament or decoration.
7. Cookbook.
8. Magazine.
9. Newspaper.
10. Map or atlas.
11. Sports memorabilia.
12. Toy or doll.
13. Hand tool, no larger than 18”.
14. Postcard.
15. Calendar.
16. Handkerchief.
17. Pillowcase, hand embroidered.
18. Woman’s gloves.
19. Advertisement / can, bottle or package.
20. Wind up alarm clock.
