Notations

- Historical interest and approximate age of entry would be appreciated but not necessary for a prize.
- Small cracks / flaws will not disqualify items.
- Items must be small enough to be handheld.
- Only amateurs may enter, no collectors.
- Items will be displayed in a fenced area.

3. Early kitchen utensil. (e.g., washboard, rolling pin, mixing bowl, butter print, etc.)

6. Salt and pepper shakers.
7. Church plate – commemorative or souvenir.
8. Coin, token, or paper money.
9. Christmas ornament or decoration.
10. Cookbook.
11. Magazine or newspaper.
12. Map or atlas.
13. Greeting card.
14. Sports memorabilia.
15. Toy or doll.
16. Hand tool, no larger than 18".
17. Postcard.
18. Calendar.
19. One room school photo, students optional.
20. Teacher's school bell.
21. Candle mold.
22. Handkerchief.
23. Pillowcase, hand embroidered.
24. Woman's gloves.
25. Advertisement on a can, bottle or package.
26. Wind up alarm clock.
27. Baby shoes.
28. Child's book.
29. Any previous item not previously listed.
