#### Rules

1. While no entry fee is required for this event, all participants must be pre-registered.
2. Open to children from 4 up to and including 9 years of age.
3. Children entering must be able to participate in the fair's Official Opening Ceremony on Thursday at 6:00 p.m. and the Sunday Parade at 2:00 p.m.

#### Procedures

1. All participants will be taken up on to the stage. Each participant will be called to centre stage, one at a time, where he/she will randomly select a question from the question box. The Master of Ceremonies will then ask the child the question after which he/she may return to the group.
2. A panel of judges will make the selection of a Mini King and Mini Queen. All decisions are final.
3. This is NOT a beauty contest.
4. Prizes will be awarded to the Mini King and Queen and all other participants.
5. The Mini King and Queen are required to participate in the opening ceremony of the fair and the parade.
